## Tsunami Survival

The roaring waves and destructive force of the tsunami have left you and your team in a life-or-death situation. In this scenario, your collective survival instincts, teamwork, and quick decision-making will be crucial to overcoming the challenges that lie ahead.

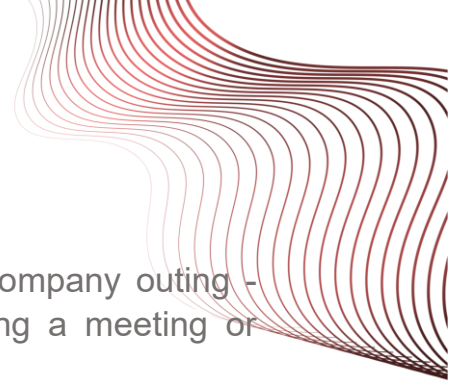
#### How it Works:

In the "Tsunami Survival" team-building activity, participants experience the mechanics of handling a tsunami disaster scenario. The activity unfolds through a series of crucial steps to ensure survival and team cohesion. Firstly, teams must quickly evacuate to higher ground, collaborating to identify the safest and highest locations away from the coastline. Once secure, they gather supplies, searching for washed-up debris and natural resources, and then develop a plan to ration food and water for sustainable survival. Building sturdy shelters using available materials becomes essential for protection from the elements and a central point for organizing efforts. Finally, teams work together to devise a rescue plan, creating visible and sound-based signals to increase their chances of being spotted and rescued amidst the crisis. This immersive experience tests teamwork, communication, and strategic thinking in a high-stakes environment.
