

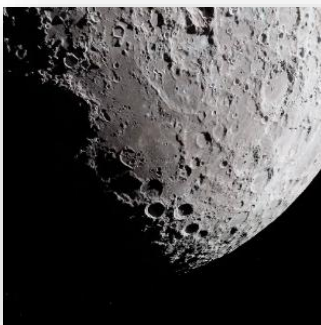
Survival on the Moon

How it Works:

In the "Survival on the Moon" team-building activity, participants engage in a simulated lunar survival mission, facing a series of critical mechanics to ensure their team's survival. The first task is to assess and repair the lunar module collaboratively, utilizing available tools and equipment to restore functionality and establish communication with mission control. With limited oxygen and food supplies, teams must explore the lunar surface to find resources and develop a rationing plan, prioritizing vital needs and maximizing resource efficiency. To increase their chances of rescue, teams work together to design and construct visible signals using lunar materials and establish communication systems to transmit distress signals back to Earth. Additionally, participants learn about the lunar environment, adapting their strategies to overcome challenges such as gravity, temperature extremes, and atmospheric pressure. This immersive experience strengthens teamwork, problem-solving, and adaptability in the unique context of lunar survival.
